

GREENBUSH BAPTIST MISSION

HISTORY

In Sept., 1979 Greenbush Baptist Mission was started with backyard bible studies and vacation bible schools. Revival at Greenbush school by Salem Association from Kentucky.

Bro. John Stutz was called as first pastor. Bro. John left in June, 1980.

Bro. Gary Reynolds was called as pastor in July, 1980. Bro. Gary left in October, 1980.

At that time we were meeting in the Greenbush School. We lost the use of the Greenbush School in Sept., 1980 and moved into the Associational tent on the associations lot. We used the tent until the Associational Office was under roof. Then we moved into the office with a construction heater for heat.

In Feb., 1981 Bro. Ray Hatton was called to be pastor.

We received financial help from Farmdale Church, Lincoln County Assoc. and Salem Association of which Salem Association is still helping, financially and physically, in our work.

A five acre lot was bought through Home Mission Board by Central Baptist Church while Bro. Joe Bridges was pastor and before mission was started. The lot was payed off by Greenbush Mission in June, 1983.

Our building fund was started in Cotober, 1983 with \$1,000.00. We now have \$14,656.86 in our building fund, which if God be willing, we will use very shortly for this cause.

Greenbush Baptist Mission instituted into a church on August 23, 1987.
